### **Ride-A-Long Program Dress Code**

All personnel participating in the Ride-A-Long program, shall adhere to the following dress code:

1. The shirt shall be plain white, button up with collar, either long or short sleeves. There shall be no logos or identifying markings on the shirt.
2. Pants shall be navy blue or black dress style. Navy blue or black "Dockers" are acceptable, denim in any form is not acceptable. Pants shall be full length.
3. Shoes shall be black in color, highly polished and shall provide ankle protection.
4. All participating personnel shall wear a "Observer" identification card at all times while participating in this program. The identification card is to be clipped to the shirt or outerwear and must be clearly visible at all times.
5. Outerwear shall consist of a yellow rain coat, or a navy blue or red wind breaker or coaches jacket. If outerwear is worn the "Observer" identification card is to be worn on the jacket.

The on duty crew chief shall be responsible assuring compliance with this dress code. Ride-a-long program participants who fail to comply with this dress code will not be permitted to participate in the program and will not, under any circumstances, be permitted to accompany Dorchester County EMS on emergency responses.

Failure to comply with this dress code will result in termination from the ride-a-long program.
